

Formatting Quick Reference

Font Styles



You can use the **Bold** button on the toolbar of your Edit window to bold selected text, or you can apply the following wiki formatting:

Bold

`'''bold'''`

Italic

`"'italic'"`

Bold Italic

`''''bold''''`

Underline

`_underline_`

Strike-Through

`~~strikethrough~~`

Headings



You can use the **Heading** button on the toolbar of your Edit window to apply a Heading 2 style to selected text, or you can apply the following wiki formatting:

`= Heading 1 =`

`== Heading 2 ==`

`=== Heading 3 ===`

`==== Heading 4 ====`

Paragraphs



The wiki automatically creates a new text paragraph whenever you separate two blocks of text by one or more empty lines.

You can also use the **Paragraph** button on the toolbar of your Edit window to create a new paragraph by inserting your cursor where you want the paragraph break and clicking the **Paragraph** button.

Insert a hard line break by inserting your cursor where you want the hard line break and clicking the **Line Break** button or by inserting `[[BR]]`

Lists

You can have an ordered or unordered list. Pay close attention to your spaces!

Create unordered lists by inserting **a space followed by an asterisk followed by another space** followed by the list item:

- * First item in my list
- * Second item in my list
- * Third item in my list

Create ordered lists by inserting **a space followed by a number or letter followed by another space** followed the list item:

- 1 First item in my list
- 2 Second item in my list
- 3 Third item in my list

Simple Tables

Create simple tables like this:

```
|| Cell 1 || Cell 2 || Cell 3 ||  
|| Cell 4 || Cell 5 || Cell 6 ||
```

Horizontal Line



Add a horizontal line with four or more dashes or by clicking the **Horizontal Rule** button.
